CPR & FIRST AID

CPR and first aid training is a mandatory requirement of the Faculty for all pharmacy students. The class of 1T3 has made arrangements for a discounted group rate for those of you who have not had training. The course will cover Level C CPR and Standard First Aid as required by the Faculty.
